Referring to the writer's call
at your office on Wednesday last, and to
the conversation he then had with Mr.
Cornish, regarding the equipment of anchors
& chains for our Nos 56, 57 & 59, we would
respectfully ask that the decision recently
come to, may be re-considered by your Com-
mittee.

As pointed out to Mr. Cornish, these
vessels are practically in every respect
duplicates of our No 51, but the tonnage

unfortunately comes out about 5 tons more.

You will observe by the Plans which
were left with you, that the new vessels
have slightly more sheer forward than No 51.

Unfortunately the whole of these anchors
and chains have been made and delivered to
us, and two vessels have at present left with
them on board. We trust therefore that the
Committee, on re-consideration, may be able
to see their way to meet us in this matter,
by allowing these equipments to pass, as they
did in No 51.
