The firm of Messrs. Hawthorn & Co. (Lim) are building 3 line fishing steamers
N^o 56. 57 & 59 (sister ships) to class 100 A1 for fishing purposes; N^o 56 being
completed; N^o 57 launched today & N^o 59 plated, and it is now found, that the
Und. R.R. Tonnage is 105.12 tons, the anchors & chains supplied being as per Rule for vessels
of 80 & under 100 tons: the 2 lower anchors collectively ^{est. grs lbs} 7.0.7; Kedge ^{est.} 2.0.0; stud chain
¹³/₁₆ instead of respectively: 8.0.0; 2.1.0 & ¹⁴/₁₆ chain req^d for vessels over 100 tons. -

As explained in a letter rec^d. from the builders, herewith enclosed, it was not anticipated
that the tonnage would exceed that of the sister ship "Chancellor" (yard N^o 51), 99 tons,
and I have therefore to submit for favorable consideration the builders application
for approval of the equipment as now supplied. -
