Copy of a letter received from Mr. Wilson the Society's Surveyor at Middlesbro' dated the 6th October, 1896.

I beg to inform you that Messrs. R. Craggs & Sons' new vessels No. 121 ("READY") No. 122 ("RAPID") and No. 123 ("PACER") have left this port for London, where they will receive their machinery.

In order to complete the survey on these vessels, in each case the casings round the E. & B. openings in the deck require to be riveted, and the engine suction to the various compartments connected up.

It is respectfully submitted that the Surveyors in London should be advised of the above.

The first entry reports will be forwarded as soon as the Registered particulars are obtained.
