With reference to your letters of 15th
and 27th Jan^y and enclosed correspondence
relating to the smack Robert Hadden^s
I beg to inform you that upon notice having
been given at this office that the vessel
was ready for survey a visit was made to
her with a recommendation that she should
be placed on a slipway. Upon the appended
telegram being received from the Board
he was replied to as follows (see copy of telegram)
"Smack Robert Hadden must go on slip &
"hold satisfactory survey"

No further communication having
been received here I visited the vessel
today and found her loaded. I was then
informed by the Master that the vessel
was about to proceed to Dumbarton (Glasg)
but received no message from the Board
as

as to the course he contemplated taking
with respect to the survey in question.
