Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 19th instant, respecting the case of the ship " WINDERMERE," I have to acquaint you that I have been in communication with the owners, who state that the fees should be paid by the builders as usual, and I have therefore written Messrs.Oswald & Co. a letter of which I enclose a copy for your information.

With regard to Mr.Oswald's statement that the printed form of request which you asked him to fill up for the 264 vessel was something new, I have to acquaint you that the filling up and signing of these forms by the builders is an essential preliminary, and is required in every case, and I have to request that you will at once obtain Messrs.Oswald's signature to these request forms for their No.262, 263, and 264 vessels, and let me have them as soon as possible.
