since she was built, I have to state that in  
1841 I gave her a complete overhaul in Greenock  
etc. The Aid at that time was opened in small  
parts & found to be perfectly free from decay. I may  
mention that I built the Aid in 1826 & was thoroughly  
assured in her frame, being nearly two years in com-  
pletion. Her Timber is all English oak. I planked  
with English & Danish Oak plank-
