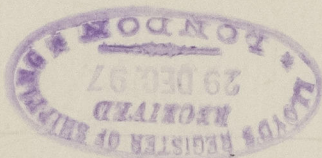

In reply to the London letter of the 21<sup>st</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> respecting a double boiler made by Mess<sup>rs</sup> Cochran & Coy of this port. and recently fitted on board the s.s. Miyajima at Nagasaki. I regret to say that Mess<sup>rs</sup> Cochran & Coy are unable to find the exact date of this boiler's construction although about the end of 1893 several boilers of their standard type 4' 6" dia x 10' 0" high 80 lbs W. Pressure were constructed to foreign orders, and tested by hyd. Pressure to 160 lbs. All the steel used by Mess<sup>rs</sup> Cochran & Coy is tested by our Surveyors at the makers works.
