In view of the scantlings given
on the first entry report, it is submitted
that provided a middle line keelson
formed of double angles $5 \times 3 \times \frac{5}{16}$, ^{provided} and
the vessel has been surveyed in accordance
with Special Survey No 3 and found
in good & efficient condition, ^{and the scantlings found as stated} she will
merit the favorable consideration of
the Committee to be classed A-
"For river & coasting purposes".

In reference to the remarks that the class of this vessel
required for insurance on her voyage to Columbia, the
owner should be informed that the class is "for River & coasting
purposes", and for an oversea voyage special arrangements
should be made with his underwriters.
