now clasped 6 A 1 for the purpose of
ascertaining if she be eligible to be
raised to an higher class—

The materials appear to be of
the description required for 8 A.—

The Transoms are trawny and
the Stern Frame very roughly got
together— It has already been
found necessary to shift 600 Tons
& 36 extra bolts have been put

through the Planks of
the Bottom, and the Scuppers
of the Keel have been extra
botted.

The original report of
survey represents that
the Frame is of very inferior
quality. This taken in connection
with what we can see prevents
our recommending her for
a higher class than that in
which she at present stands
