

New Iron Screw Steamer "Edendale" built at

It is submitted that the Surveyors should  
be requested to state (with reference to the Secretary's  
letter 23/1/85 when the plans were submitted) what means  
have been adopted to ensure that the deep fore peak  
is completely filled when in use for water  
ballast, and also to what head of water above  
the crown it has been tested to ascertain its efficiency,  
and whether the additional strengthening was arranged  
to their complete satisfaction. The Surveyors should  
also state whether strong hold beams and web  
frames have been introduced under the long  
raised quarter deck as required in the Secretary's  
letter referred to. These points should have  
been made clear by a statement on the report.
