This rudder quadrant has been tested according to the requirements of the Committee and found satisfactory

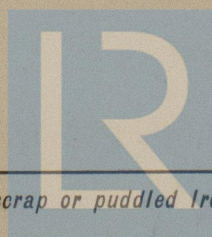
