



I am in receipt of Mr. Gilmour's letter of the 11th instant, forwarding one from Messrs. Smith's Dock Co., respecting the S.S. "CANONESA" (ex "BUTESHIRE"), and with regard thereto I send herewith for your use in carrying out the 2nd Special Survey No.3 at your port, the first entry report and approved plans of the vessel, together with the Midship Section and Profile of the sister ship "PERTSHIRE".

With regard thereto I have to say that you are at liberty to exhibit the sketches of Midship Section and Profile to Smith's Dock Co., who are carrying out the work, provided you are satisfied that the Owners are agreeable to the same being done.

With reference to the question as to the removal of insulation, the Society will be prepared to consider any proposal from the Owners regarding this matter when you are in a position to state definitely the amount of insulation removed on account of repairs, and the quantity then remaining in the vessel.
