Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification with this Society of your steamer "TRELEIGH", I beg to remind you that this vessel's character was assigned by the Committee, subject to the equipment being made equal to the requirements of the Rules.

It appears that the new anchors and chains required have been placed on board the vessel, but that no opportunity was afforded the Society's Surveyors of comparing them with the certificates of test.

Under the circumstances, I shall be glad if you will kindly let me know when and at what port it will be convenient for you to have the anchors and chains examined by one of the Society's Officers and compared with the certificates, with a view to the steamer's class being recorded in the Register Book.
