Nature of Survey

Classification

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee, the First Entry report, approved tracing of midship section, and of rudder, should be returned to the Surveyor, and he should be requested to give the correct depth from top of floor to main deck beams, and to state whether the angles to margin plate are $3\frac{1}{2} \times 3\frac{1}{2} \times 8$, as given by him on the First Entry report ^{are correct} as the Rules require them to be $4 \times 4 \times 9/20$. He should also make the report, midship section, and tracing of rudder, agree with regard to the size of the rudder as fitted.
