Nature of Survey Improved class.

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Newcastle Surveyors should be requested to state whether the kedge anchor on board is of the weight required by Table 22. They should also be requested to state whether a certificate has been produced for the steel stream wire.

Further action should be deferred pending receipt of their reply, and particulars of stream anchor when tested.
