& in which the weights of
the Stream & Kedge Anchors
is asked for, we find the
Stream Anchor weighs
about $1\frac{3}{4}$ Cwts & would

like to know if this
Anchor will require to
be tested. The weight
is above Rule requirements
the Rules requiring a
Stream Anchor only $1\frac{1}{2}$ Cwts
in weight.

We take it that this
Anchor will not require
the test but will be
pleased to hear from you on
the matter at your earliest
