I beg to submit for the consideration of the Committee, a plan shewing the structural alteration to the boiler room of the S.S. Ingeli, proposed to be made by Messrs Swan Hunter & Wigham Richardson's Pontoon Dept.

The owners are having the present boilers removed & substituting shorter ones & propose to reduce the length of the Boiler Space, & re-arrange the cross bunkers as shewn, also to remove the main deck plating as indicated on plan
