For caulking both topsides of above named ship, moving it to and from the sheerhulk and heaving it down on both sides, in order to survey the bottom, agreed by tender of October the 18th for -

According to our agreement of October the 29th, stripped of the old metal from the keel up to the wooden sheathing, hoarsed and caulked the ship from the keel seam up to said wooden sheathing, then covered it with a mixture of Swedish tar and pitch and put sheathing felt and new yellow metal on; all this agreed, delivery of the new yellow metal and sheathing nails excepted, for -
