For caulking both lapsides of above named ship, moving it to and from the sheerhulk and bearing it down on both sides, in order to survey the bottom, agreed by tender of October the 18<sup>th</sup> for -

According to our agreement of October the 29<sup>th</sup>, stripped off the old metal from the keel up to the wooden sheathing, hoisted and caulked the ship from the keel down up to said wooden sheathing, then covered it with a mixture of Swedish tar and pitch and put sheathing felt and new yellow metal on; all this agreed, delivery of the new yellow metal and sheathing nails excepted, for -
