

Dutch Ship "L. J. Enthoven" 692  
Tons built at Kenderdyk in 1864 and  
now recommended to be classed  
Restored & A-1.

This vessel appears to be eligible  
to be classed A in Red for 5 years  
from 1876, and it is respectfully  
submitted that when the fillings  
which form the covering board are  
removed for the examination of the  
top-timbers in accordance with Section  
56, upon a favorable report being  
received she will be eligible to  
be classed as recommended viz.  
A Restored 1876 for 4 years.

The equipment is not in conformity  
with the requirements of Table 22  
there being 105 fathoms of  $1\frac{10}{16}$ , 105  
fathoms of  $1\frac{7}{16}$  and 90 fathoms of 1 inch  
instead of 240 fathoms of  $1\frac{8}{16}$   
as required by the Rules, and a stream  
chain of  $1\frac{13}{16}$  -
