tested as required by the Rules, and the boilers be built and
tested in accordance with the plan submitted and with the
provisions of the Rules, and to the entire satisfaction of the
local Engineer Surveyor, they will be approved of for the
intended working pressure of 80 pounds per square inch.

The plan referred to is returned herewith, and should
accompany the reports when transmitted to the Committee.
