Sir,

In reply to London letter of 29th July
respecting S.S. "Le de la Reunion"
I beg to enclose report as amended
Respecting the doubling of stem stroke. This
doubling was arranged not to be fitted
by Mr. T. Clark of Sir James Lamb with
Mr. Cornish on account of the plating being
joggled, the stem stroke is increased 2/20
and the stroke above sheer of bridge side
plating is also increased 2/20 at ends of bridge
in lieu of doubling. No middle line pillars
are fitted. 5 inch hand pump is fitted to fore peak
The profile plan as corrected and mid section
are returned herewith. Plan showing connection
to pillars enclosed. I am Sir
