error has risen in the drawing up of Bk "Jealous's"  
Report. the mistake arose in copying off Mr. Branton's  
notes - and in place of "Eng. & For<sup>st</sup> Oak" should have  
been - Transoms &c. "Eng. & African Oak." the vessel has  
no Foreign Oak timber in the frame, except the African.  
We trust that the above explanation will be deemed  
satisfactory, and the character of the vessel put forward.
