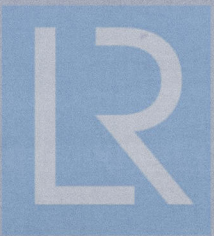
Stockton-on-Tees, June 3. 1853

The new ship William
and Jane built by White at
Sunderland and which sustain-
ed injury by lavishing having
been docked at west Hartlepool
dry dock. I beg to inform you
that the timbers have been
dismantled and renewed on the
side also shifted a piece of
plank on her so as to enable them
to get the ship to her proper form
also put in the stowage side riders
and caulked all the outside in
the way of the same all has gone
hard recommended and that
the ship is now in a good and
efficient state
