A ship (not named) of 970 Tons
built by Messrs. Thompson & Sons for
Mr. Graham of Newcastle under S.S.
of Mr. Lawrence for $\frac{13}{13}$ $\frac{1}{2}$ recently launched.

Found her lying afloat masted
& part cargo of Coal on board, going
to the Tyne to be Docked & coppered, she
has thick Angular clamps to each
range of Beams, staple lodging knees
in all spaces at each Deck, a pair
of Vertical knees or staple standards
to every Beam of Upper Deck, the
side arms of these knees have but
three bolts, & the staple standards
but four bolts, but there being more knees
in number than the Rules require,
the Committee may probably deem them
sufficient, on the whole she appears
a good ship.
