We the undersigned builders of the "Clandini"  
150 tons Register hereby certify that the materials  
fastenings and workmanship of the said ship  
are in accordance with Lloyd's rules for the  
8 years A.S. Classification and that she was  
surveyed during building by Mr. James Lloyd  
Surveyor and every timber condemned by him  
was removed & replaced by others to his satisfaction  
That the planking which he pointed out as deficient  
was made good - That she has 9 hold beams with 4 pair  
of long knees or riders and otherwise securely fastened -  
That she has 20 deck beams with 12 iron hanging knees on each  
side <sup>iron or</sup> wood lashing knees to every beam - That her Kelsons  
are of Stettin Oak 12 inches by 21 inches, and that she was  
built and intended for the 8 years class and we are not  
aware of anything to prevent her being entitled to that  
class
