

"Carnatic" Extract from M<sup>r</sup> Martin's Report  
Dated 4<sup>th</sup> Sept. 1867

As regards the Comp. Ship "Carnatic",  
M<sup>r</sup> Lawrence's Letter of the 27<sup>th</sup> Ult<sup>o</sup> states as  
follows "The Timber used in the construction  
of this Vessel is in accordance with Table "I"  
of the Committee's suggestions for 14 Years  
Class, the Bolts are also as per Table "K",  
entitling her to Class 3 Years additional."

And referring to the Letter of 31<sup>st</sup> Ult<sup>o</sup>  
Signed by M<sup>r</sup> Lawrence and the other three  
Surveyors at Sunderland, with the Table of  
comparisons prepared by them, same states;  
it will be seen that the "Carnatic" (built  
previous to the promulgation of Committee's  
Suggestions for building such Ship) is slightly  
below some requirements for details, but  
they do not appear to be of sufficient  
importance, under the circumstances, when  
she was built, so as to recommend the  
Committee to withhold the "16 D" Class,  
which is applied for <sup>by</sup> the Owners M<sup>rs</sup>.  
J & J Wait, in their Letter of the 24<sup>th</sup> Ult<sup>o</sup>,  
such Classification having been already  
granted by the Committee in similar  
Vessels recently.
