With regard to the moulded depth, that shown on the Report is quite correct, and the vessel has the normal amount of round of beam, but this is one of those

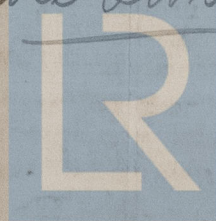
those cases which were reported to the Committee some time ago, in which the lowest point in the sheer is abaft the midship frame.
