Sir:

In reply to London letter of the 15<sup>th</sup> May  
re report on "S.S. Untali" I beg to give the following  
explanation.

I beg respectfully to state that the Spar deck  
plating consists of one stroke 9/20 thick nearly the  
whole length and partly 8/20, the other stroke next the  
strut is 7/20 but does not extend the whole length  
on account of the form of the vessel. On main deck  
the stroke of plating near openings is 8/20, the other stroke  
7/20. Under these circumstances it would be better to describe  
Spar deck plating as 9 & 8/20 at openings, remainder 7/20 as  
amended on report. The length of water ballast  
tanks are correctly given on report, the profile plan has  
not been corrected in this respect. I beg to enclose  
a corrected profile plan showing alteration  
in this respect.



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- (1) The spar deck is entirely sheathed with wood and freeboard is marked from top of wood deck as stated on freeboard report.
- (2) The number of bulkheads required by rule should be 5 not 6 as stated.
- (3) The Butts of T staves are riveted with 7/8 rivets  $3\frac{1}{8}$  apart with  $16\frac{3}{4}$  straps as stated on report.
- (4) The Table riveted straps of A.B.C.D.E.F.G.H. staves should be 9" wide as amended

Particulars of prop. deck tie plate and riveting of Doge Bridge & forecastle side plating are given on report. Trusting that the report is now in order. The mid section plan should be corrected as to wood sheathing on Spar deck extending the whole length. Report enclosed herewith
