

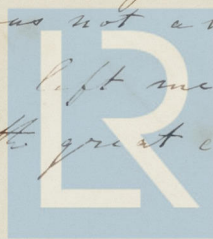

Southampton 19<sup>th</sup> April 1859

Dear Sir

In reply to your note of the 10<sup>th</sup> inst touching my Report No 925 on Messrs H. Pell & Holmes new Brig not named I beg in reply to say that no special fee is due on this vessel as Mr. Holmes explained to me when the ship was first laid down that he would pay <sup>special</sup> none.

I have been exceedingly ill for the last two months or more proceeding in the first instance from a slight cold and at this time the weather was very cold and wet and having occasion to go away more just at this particular time and not taking that care that I ought to have done I got more cold and completely lost my appetite and for five six weeks I was not able to eat anything but Beef Steak which left me so weak that I am obliged to move with great care now.

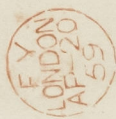
