to "Annual Special Surveys", in the late
Liverpool Underwriters Registry, ^{last date}
^{of survey 11.79}

A First Entry Report from specifying
the Scantling stated to have been measured
from the Ship is attached herewith and the
Vessel is recommended by the Surveyor
for the Q5 A1 class.

It is submitted that before the
claim of this vessel to have a character
assigned in this Society's Registry Book can
be considered, the Surveyor, Mr. Postelmann,
should be informed that the vessel must be
submitted to a "Second Special Survey no. 3";
the condition of the Scantling ascertained; the
shell plating drilled at such parts as the
Surveyors may consider necessary to satisfy
themselves as to its thickness, the number
of holes on each side in no case being
less than the number of strokes of plating
not covered with cement. A sketch showing
the thicknesses at the parts where drilled
should accompany the Report on the vessel,
for the consideration of the Committee, and,
the Report should state, fully and in
detail, the extent of the examination
made and, if necessary, of the repairs
subsequently executed.

In view of the serious discrepancies

which appears to exist between the
scantlings as ascertained by Mr. Costelmans
and those recorded in this office, it is
further submitted that the Surveyors at
Bristol should carefully check their
measurements and amend the same as
may be found necessary -

A copy (also attached) of the
scantlings reported for the vessel at the time
she was classed in 1878 should be
forwarded to the Surveyors for their guidance
in dealing with this case.
