

Iron S.S. "Nishnij Novgorod" late
"Saxonia" 2602 Tons gross - built in
1857 and Classed A.1.1 in Black
Ironing deck & subject to annual
survey in the Liverpool Registry.

In 1881 the late Owners declined
to fulfil the requirements of the survey
and the vessel's class lapsed.

In June last she was surveyed at
Sevastopol by ~~Mr~~ Bostelman the Society's
surveyor at Odessa and Mr Artsavuloff
the surveyor at Sebastopol - who recommended
the vessel to be Classed 95 A.1. The
Committee however declined to assign a
Class to the vessel until she had been
specially surveyed by an Exclusive
Surveyor. The vessel will arrive
at Hull shortly and the Owners
state that they are prepared to submit
her ~~to a~~ survey with a view to
classification in the Register Book.

It is submitted that the
Sevastopol report should be forwarded
to the Hull Surveyors, and they should
be requested to give special attention
to this vessel in view of her great age,
viz 34 yrs. The full requirements of the
Second Special Survey No 3 should be complied
with, and the plating drilled, ^{as required and} where considered
necessary by the Surveyor, and the
particulars of the drilling submitted for
the information of the Committee as early
as possible.

as possible. Before the Survey is undertaken the Owners representative should be informed of the whole of the requirements of the rules, and if great deterioration is found, the parts required to be renewed or doubled should be pointed out to the Owner at an early date, and as nearly as practicable the whole of the recommendations of the Surveyor should be made before ^{large} ~~great~~ repairs are entered into.
