In consequence of defects ^(being all rotten) not rotten see Sur. No. 30 April 1856
 Has had ten outside planks below the
 wales taken out and replaced with Red pine & Pitch Pine, Has also had
 21 Pairs of Iron Knee Riders & extend down to take two bolts in a
 Substantial part of the floors, one Pair of Short Hanging knees forward
 the wake of the Breasthooks under the hold beams,
 3 Pairs of Iron hanging knees under the upper deck beams, one
 on Crutch aft, the rudder is well secured the Rindles & braces
 very good and well fastened, Has now on board 2 1/2 fathoms 1 1/2
 and 1 5/8 inch Chain cable 90 fathoms of which tested the remainder
 old Chain but very good, 90 fathoms of 9 inch Stream warp
 90 fathom of 7 1/2 & 90 ditto of 5 1/2 inch warps, 3 Bower anchors
