

Extract from Letter, dated
Liverpool 14th April 1850.

I return herewith, also as desired, the St. John Report, No. 354, on the Ship "Hebe", it would seem that this Vessel was fitted with Iron knees &c while here, but that in consequence of the Owners not having applied for the attendance of the Surveyors, but, on the contrary, having intimated their intention of taking her round to London for Classification, the Surveyors did not think it requisite for them to give her their attention; indeed, Mr. Perkins, in whose district the work was done, would appear to have been informed by the Shipwrights that the Services of the Surveyors were not required in consequence of the arrangement alluded to.
