this Society as amended I beg to inform
you that having inspected the vessel
building for registration of P & B since
the law. I respectfully recommend as
highly desirable that the vessel & her
waterway which is not worked in
accordance with the rules be remedied
— if the vessel exceed 100 tons register
the flying surface against timbers should be
5^m — before she is reported to the
Committee to be craped in the register
book.
