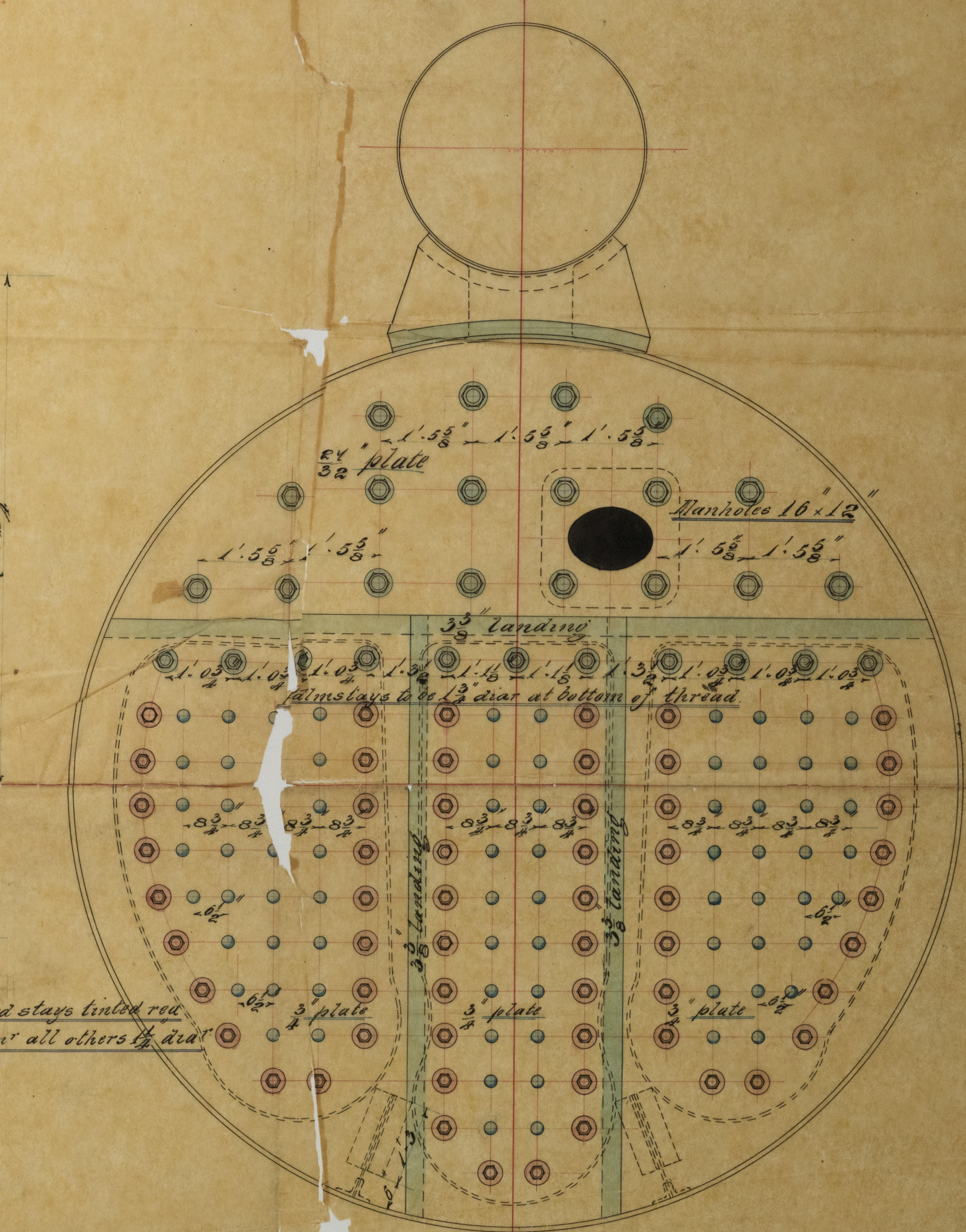
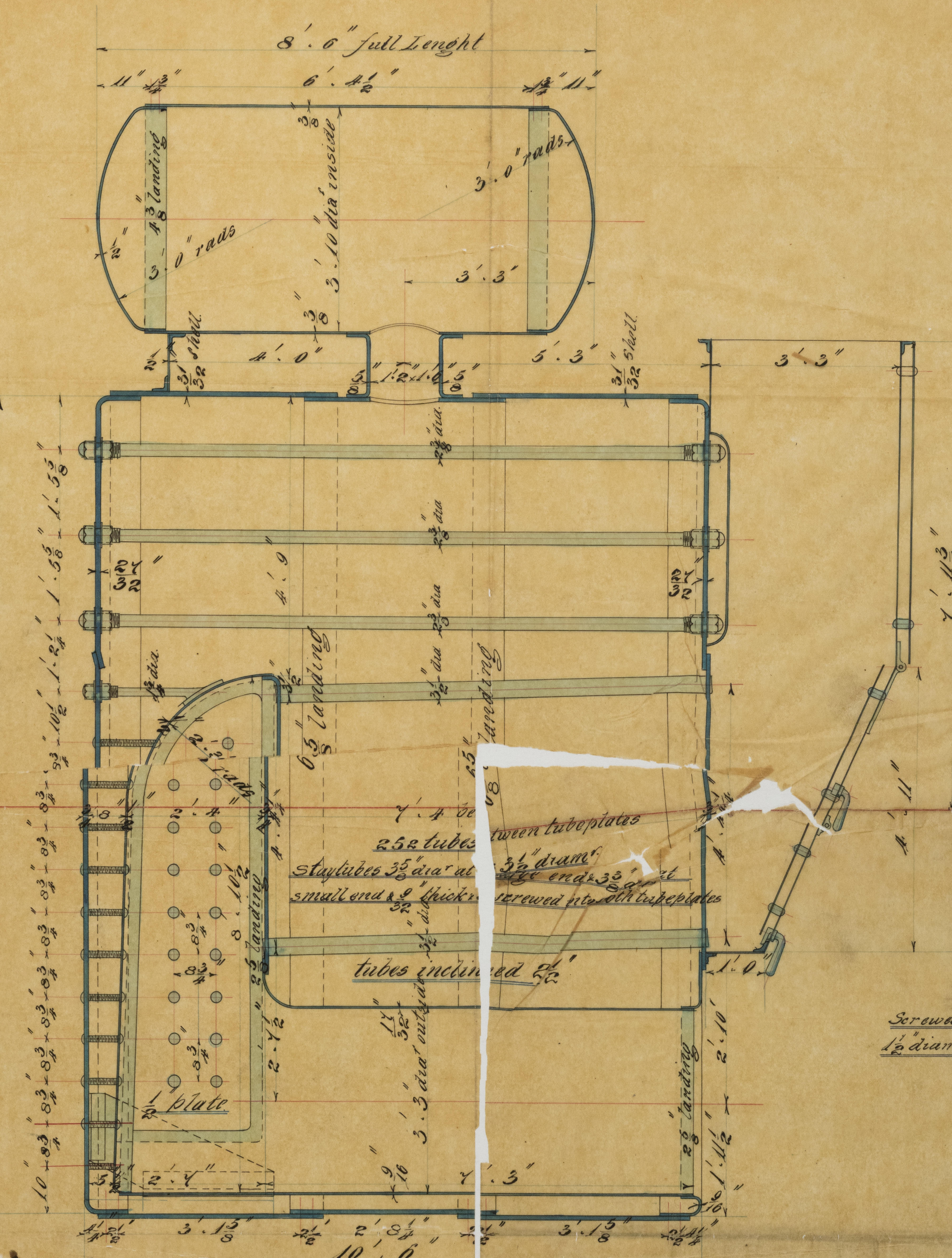

Horizontal seams triple riveted 1 1/2" rivets 5 1/2" pitch, drilled holes.
Circumferential seams double rivetted 1 1/2" rivets 3 1/2" pitch, punched holes.
Front & Back single rivetted 1 1/2" rivets 3" pitch.
Longitudinal seams double rivetted 1 1/2" rivets 3 1/2" pitch, drilled holes.
Dome { Circumferential seams single rivetted 1 1/2" rivets 2 1/2" pitch punched holes.
