Sir,

I have to inform you that it appears the Trinity Yacht "VESTAL" has been, or is to be purchased by Messrs. Christie & Co., of Cardiff, and is now at Milford where it is desired that she may be surveyed with a view to classification. I have therefore to request that you will join with the Society's Surveyor at Milford in surveying this vessel, and forward as soon as possible a rough sketch of the midship section shewing as far as practicable the scantlings and arrangements, and report upon the condition of the vessel and how it is proposed to sub-divide the vessel for the purpose of carrying petroleum in bulk, for the information of the Committee in dealing with the Owners' request for the vessel to be classed in the Society's Register Book. It will be convenient if the scantlings as far as practicable are also shewn on a first entry report form.

For your guidance I send herewith the original report of particulars when the vessel was built, but not classed.

I have to add that the Owners desire you to attend at Milford on Thursday next, the 1st. proximo, and you should make arrangements accordingly.

A copy of this letter is being sent to the Surveyor at Milford for his information and guidance.
