It is submitted the Surveyors at Newcastle should be requested to report promptly whether in connection with the fitting of the machinery on board this vessel the casing round the hatchways and all other necessary work to complete the hull has been carried out to their satisfaction. They should also state whether the equipment has been completed by supplying properly tested stream and kedge anchors of the required weights. As the Owners are requesting the classing certificate the Surveyors should report in the usual form as soon as practicable. G.S.
