Before this case receives the consideration of the Committee it is submitted instructions should be sent that in view of the instructions sent on the 2^d May to the Newcastle Surveyors, Mr. Boulds should arrange with Mr. Hake, who repeatedly visited the vessel while the machinery was being placed on board, to furnish a report on the work done to the hull at N. Shields in connection with the machinery survey. At the same time he should obtain from the Owners documentary evidence that a stream anchor (3 qrs. ^{per rule} stock) and a kedge anchor (2 qrs. ^{per rule} stock) have been supplied to the vessel to complete the equipment.
