Referring to your enquiry in this matter, there were 6 anchors put on board this vessel, viz:-

3 Bowers: 1 Stream Kedge: & 2 smaller Kedges. I don't know the weights:

but by applying to Messrs J. Pile & Co of Great St Helens, London, you will doubtless be furnished with the certificates: or placed in a position to get them.

This vessel was built abroad, & received her Boilers & Engines on the Tyne. Consequently the Engine & Boiler casings were fitted here. They are of Iron 21" high & built very substantially.
