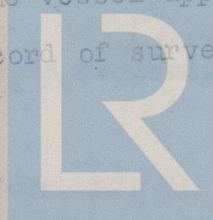
The Cardiff Surveyors report the vessel afloat and on account of damage through loading cargo some rigging was found broken.

It would appear that the damaged rigging has been renewed, but owing to an oversight on the part of the Owners the repairs were not examined.

The Surveyors recommend repairs to rigging be examined at the first opportunity.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey, subject as recommended.
