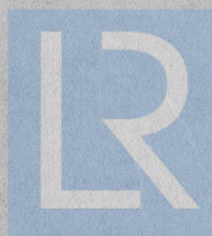
I return herewith two copies of each of the plans, forwarded with your letter of the 5th instant, of midship section and framing and bulkhead profile for steel twin screw motor vessels Nos. 1016 and 1017 proposed to be built by Messrs. Harland & Wolff, Ltd., and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended be adhered to, the Rules in all other respects be complied with, and the materials and workmanship be to the Society's satisfaction the vessels will be eligible to be classed 100A1 with a freeboard corresponding to a draught not exceeding that contemplated by the Rules for a complete superstructure vessel having a tonnage opening.

The remaining copies of the plans are being retained for reference.
