

and in the circumstances the same arrangement and apportion-  
ment of fees will obtain for each of the above vessels, as  
in the case of Messrs. Cammell Laird & Co's Yard Nos.1014/6,  
viz:-

- (1). Refrigerating Machinery Contractors...£24 per ship.
- (2). Oil Engine Builders.....£34 for 2 ships
- (3). Insulators.....£16 per ship.
