

Messrs. Harland & Wolff's Yard Nos. 1016/7.

A letter has been received from Messrs. J. & E. Hall Ltd. intimating that it is proposed to fit generally similar refrigerating installations in these ships to those previously supplied for Messrs. Cammell Laird & Co's Yard Nos. 1014 & 1016, and the Firm enquire whether the same arrangement and apportionment of fees will obtain in the present case.

It may be stated that the apportionment of the fees in the case of the two previous installations referred to was as follows:-

- (1) Refrigerating Machinery Contractors £24 per ship
- (2) Oil Engine Builders £34 for 2 ships
- (3) Insulators £16 per ship

As regards the fee for the survey of the oil engines, viz:- £34, it was made clear that this did not cover any fees and expenses in connexion with work which was sub-contracted by the Brush Electrical Eng. Co. elsewhere.

IT IS SUBMITTED Messrs. J. & E. Hall Ltd. be informed that the same arrangement and apportionment of fees will obtain for each of the vessels under notice, as in the case of Messrs. Cammell Laird & Co's Nos. 1014/6.

It should be made clear that the fee chargeable for the survey of the oil engines, viz:- £34, does not cover any fees and expenses in connexion with work which may be sub-contracted by the Brush Electrical Eng. Co. elsewhere.

The Belfast and Sheffield Surveyors should be advised.
