Harland & Wolff's Yard No.1016/7.

We duly received your letter of the 7th instant, together with the copy of a letter from Messrs. J. & E. Hall Ltd., respecting refrigerating installations to be supplied for the above vessels, prime movers to be made by The Brush Electrical Engineering Co. Ltd., Loughborough, and have to state in reply thereto that the inclusive fee of £34, (with the conditions as previously laid down) for the two ships, will about meet the case under discussion.

Whilst the survey work at Loughborough has fallen off somewhat during the last few weeks, there is every prospect of more work in the near future.

The arrangement recently concluded between The Brush Electrical Engineering Co. Ltd., and Messrs. Petters of Yeovil, for the Petter Engine to be made at the Loughborough Works is being carried out, necessitating the transfer of works plant from Yeovil, and extensive alterations at Loughborough.
