Subject to your approval we respectfully suggest that these rods be accepted if one rod is selected and cut up for tensile and bend tests with satisfactory results and the others are satisfactorily subjected to Brinell Tests.

We think it well to explain that the forge at the Brush Electrical Engineering Co. has been, or is being, dismantled to make way for the manufacture of the Petters oil engines so that in the future, forgings will be ordered out and similar cases to the one above are hardly likely to crop up.
