I have to acquaint you I am advised by the Society's Surveyors at Belfast that you desire to use 2" bore thermometer tubes as sounding pipes to the top of the insulation on the floor of Nos. 4 and 5 holds in the case of Messrs. Harland & Wolff's Yard Nos.1016/17.

With regard thereto I have to inform you that no exception will be taken to this proposal provided the tubes be straight and well insulated from the decks.

The Society's Belfast Surveyors are being advised accordingly and requested to arrange for plans showing the deck attachments to the tubes, and the number and arrangement of the tubes in each hold, to be submitted.
