We enclose herewith plans of arrangement and details of thermometer tubes, as requested in your letter of the 12th instant, With regard to Nos. 1,2 and 3 insulated holds, in addition to the thermometer tubes shown in red which are utilised for sounding above the insulation, there are of course the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " sounding pipes to the bilges as approved on the pumping plan.

In the case of Nos. 4 and 5 insulated holds, however, the thermometer tubes shown in red are the only means of sounding, for as noted in your letter sounding pipes to spaces below insulation are not required.
