I duly received your letter of the 1st instant, forwarding one received from Messrs. Harland & Wolff Ltd., together with plan, in duplicate, of auxiliary engine crankshaft proposed for their Yard Nos. 1016/17.

The plan has been examined and I have to inform you that with 4 SCSA oil engines for driving auxiliary machinery, having 6 cylinders, diameter 330 mm., stroke 580 mm., span of bearings 400 mm., maximum pressure in cylinders 500 lb. per sq. inch, M.I.P. 100 lb. per sq. inch, B.H.P. 480, and revolutions per minute 300, the following sizes of crankshaft will be approved, viz:-

Pins..... 220 mm. diameter.
Journals..... 280 mm. diameter.

The plan showing details of the crankshaft will also be approved, and one copy of this plan is returned herewith.
