Dear Sir,

We are in receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant regarding the Steamers "EMPIRE DEBEN" and "EMPIRE WINDRUSH", and in reply have to inform you that we are still waiting for the Ministry of Transport to give a decision regarding the future use of the "EMPIRE DEBEN".

The question of the surveys on the "Empire Windrush" was today discussed with Captain Dawson, Marine Superintendent for the Managers, whos stated that this was a question for the Ministry to decide.

It was pointed out to him that this vessel only has the record of Examined L.R. and that the Committee were most anxious to have the vessels with this record opened out for Special Survey, so that the condition of vessel can be reported on, also that the oil fuel tanks which have been examined at this time could be counted as part of this survey, if they so desire.


